STATIONERY AND STUDENT RESOURCE SCHEME – 2017

Most books and materials are supplied to students as part of the school's Student Resource Scheme. The School operates the scheme and Parents/Guardians pay \$120 per student, \$230 per family of two children, \$330 per family of three children, per year as a course contribution to the cost of purchase of these books and materials. The scheme is voluntary and Parents/Guardians wishing to purchase their own texts and materials should contact the Principal for full details. Only those students in the Student Resource Scheme receive books and materials from the school.

Students who are part of the scheme also receive:

- An Isis High homework diary
- School Magazine (1 copy per family)
- Subsidy for photocopying
- ID Card
- Curriculum internet usage

Students must supply their own stationery and are responsible for replacing any lost or damaged textbooks or school materials. All books and equipment supplied to students remain the property of the school.

To interpret the following list, please note:

1. Manual Arts / Home Economics and Art / Performing Arts (Dance or Drama) are each studied for one semester. Students will know via their draft timetable in their report pack, which subjects will be studied first semester.
2. The 'Essential Stationery' List and the other materials listed as 'Stationery' are to be purchased by **all students**.
3. If you are intending to join the Student Resource Scheme, the texts/materials which are listed as 'Provided by Student Resource Scheme' are for your information only. If you do not intend on joining the Student Resource Scheme, you will need to supply those items as well.
