### STUDENT RESOURCE SCHEME – 2017

Most books and materials are supplied to students as part of the school's Student Resource Scheme. The School operates the scheme and parents/guardians pay \$130 per student, \$240 per family of two children, \$350 per family of three children, per year as a course contribution to the cost of purchase of these books and materials. The scheme is voluntary and parents/guardians wishing to purchase their own texts and materials should contact the Principal for full details. Only those students in the Student Resource Scheme receive books and materials from the school.

Students who are part of the scheme also receive:

- School Magazine (1 copy per family)
- Subsidy for photocopying
- ID Card

Students must supply their own stationery and are responsible for replacing any lost or damaged textbooks or school materials. All books and equipment supplied to students remain the property of the school.
